

## Guidelines for the Farmer

### A) Community Development Programme

#### Programme (Sections 1 – 3 commence immediately):

**Section 1:** Monthly presentations on farms, focusing on *wellness as* central theme.

- a. **Films & Audiovisual PP presentations containing Wellness messages, e.g.:**
  - i. **Kruispad (Cross Roads)** – an Afrikaans film (with local actors) having a strong message regarding HIV and its effect on people's lives.
  - ii. **Better Choices** – a film about AC
  - iii. **Power Point Presentation** – a series of presentations concerning MARRIAGE
  - iv. **The Miners** – a film about ACCEPTANCE
  - v. **Crossroads** – a film about FORGIVENESS
  - vi. **As die Dop Skop** – an Afrikaans film (with local actors) having a strong message regarding THE AFTER-EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL ABUSE IN THE FAMILY
  - vii. **The Bet** – A film dealing with the topic of SELF-CONTROL
  - viii. **Die Tydbom TIK** – an Afrikaans film (with local actors) having a strong message regarding THE AFTER EFFECTS OF DRUGS
  - ix. **The Other Woman** – a film about CARING
  - x. **The Good Provider** – a film about RESPONSIBILITY
  - xi. **The Good Fight** – a film about PERSEVERANCE
  - xii. **The Piano** – a film about HONESTY
  - xiii. **Heartlines** – a film about A SECOND CHANCE IN LIFE
- b. **Interactive Adult Workshop** – discussion **before, during** and **after** the audio visual presentation. Our aim is to get people talking and making them aware of unsolved problems in their lives, and to assist them.
- c. **Second appointment** on farm within 2 weeks to assess principles which had been identified during the first presentation.

- d. **Possible coaching** for individuals and families with unsolved problems, within 36 hours after presentations, subject to the nature of individual needs.

### Section 2: Evangelism Training & Outreach Programme

- **Spiritual training programme** for ± four Christian workers who are able to read and write per farm – people who may be able to operate as cell group leaders among the rest of the workers after the JESUS Film outreach (±10 training sessions of 4 hours each).
- **JESUS Film outreach for three evenings**
  - Separately in Afrikaans on each farm.
  - Combined Xhosa outreach on one of the participating farms, should there be a need.
- **New Life in Christ cell group – Follow-up 1-6.**
  - Weekly cell group sessions covering 6 – 10 weeks separately under the leadership of the trained workers of each farm.

### Section 3: Religious Films

Monthly religious films on every farm. Not compulsory. Purpose is the further upliftment and preparation for the JESUS Film during the first month of the second quarter, when there will be an opportunity for people to get right with God.

- Something to Sing About [1x evening – Eng]
- Irma [1x evening – Afr]
- Faith like potatoes [1x evening – Eng]
- Huis studeer die Kruis [Afr]
- Jesus Film [3x evenings – Available in 1 000 languages]
- Bella [1x evening – Afr]
- Ens.

### Section 4: Weekly Leadership discussion groups among the farmers.

Excellent material, e.g. Henry Blackaby – *Spiritual Leadership*. (Details will be discussed at a later stage.)

## B) Budget

- a. Budget for the first quarter. (First two sections, to the end of the successful completion of the JESUS Film outreach.)
- b. **Enclosed with this budget:**
  - i. **100+** visits to 4x farms during the first quarter.
  - ii. Every trained worker will be provided with a manual, material, distribution material, etc.
  - iii. The JESUS Film outreach will be presented individually at every farm.
    - 1. **Three** successive evenings.
    - 2. Initial follow-up every evening **directly** after the programme.
    - 3. For the next 10 weeks **weekly** follow-ups separately at every farm by workers already trained.

## C) The road ahead

- a. During the activities of Sections 1 and 2 decisions regarding the future programme will be decided upon.
- b. There is Hope Ministries is at present in communication with Paeta in connection with Seta money refunds. In order to find out to what extent *There is Hope Ministries* may assist a farmer to recoup his expenses regarding this project you are referred to the document dealing with accreditation.
- c. Every quarter this programme is evaluated together with the farmer concerned before a decision is taken regarding the next series.
