

## SECTION 6 JESUS FILM TRAINING MANUAL

### TOPIC 1: *Spiritual Warfare At the Show*

---

#### A. **PRAY ON THE WAY TO THE SHOW AREA:**

- Be totally dependant on the Lord's Power and Guidance.
- Do repentance of sin. All unconfessed sin must be handled.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will be in **full control** of each team member.

#### B. **PRAY THE BLOOD OF JESUS (PROTECTION) OVER:**

- each team member,
- each team member's family at home
- translator
- weather
- equipment.



Ep 6:13-17 "Therefore put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and th Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled round your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. The sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."

Rom 8:37-39 "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, Or not heavenly rulers neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Also: 1 Chr 29:11)

#### C. **PRAY TOGETHER AS A TEAM ON YOUR ARRIVAL IN THE TARGET AREA — BEFORE DOING ANYTHING!**

Deut 4:29 But if from there you seek the LORD your God, you will find him if you look for him with all your heart and with all your soul.

#### D. **AS A SYMBOLIC ACT, DEFINE THE AREA BY WALKING (FOUR TEAM MEMBERS), IN THE FOUR DIFFERENT WIND DIRECTIONS, CLAIMING THE AREA FOR CHRIST.**

Ps 125:2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people both now and for evermore.

Josh 1:3 I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.

#### E. **TAKE UP YOUR POSITION IN CHRIST.**

Luke 10:19 *I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.*

1 Cor 15:57 But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.  
 1 John 4:4 You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.  
 Eph 2:4-6



**F. DO SPIRITUAL WARFARE:** (Sp Research S6, T4, Page 145)

**1) Identify demonic strongholds (bondages).**

Ancestor worship, witch craft, sexual immorality, alcohol mis-use etc.....

**2) Bind these strongholds in the Name of Jesus Christ.**

Math 16:19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be {Or have been} bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be {Or have been} loosed in heaven."

**3) Rebuke the work of Satan by what Christ did on Calvary.**

Acts 19:18-20 Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed their evil deeds. A number who had practised sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly. In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power.  
 1 John 3:8 The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.  
 Col 2:15 And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.  
 John 16:33 "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."  
 Gal 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."  
 James 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

**The Bible instructs us to act in the following five ways against the enemy:**

• Bind him

Matt 12:29 "Or again, how can anyone enter a strong man's house and carry off his possessions unless he first ties up the strong man? Then he can rob his house."

Matt 16:19 "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

• Cast him out

Mark 16:17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons

• Trample upon him

Ps 91:13 You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent

• Withstand him

Eph 6:13 Therefore put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you

• Give him no place

Ep 4:26-7 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold.

**4) Pray for the salvation of every person - each one who has been predestined (chosen) before the creation of the earth.**

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

**5) Know that Satan misleads them by filling their hearts with doubt, fear, bitterness and wrong thoughts**

2 Tim 2:25,26 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do His will and make them blind for the truth

2 Cor 3:14-18 But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away. Even to this day when Moses is read, a veil covers their hearts. But whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect {Or contemplate} the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit

**6) As a Christian you have Spiritual weapons at your disposal to destroy the works of the enemy.**

Jer 5:14 Therefore this is what the LORD God Almighty says: "Because the people have spoken these words, I will make my words in your mouth a fire and these people the wood it consumes.

Rom 1:16-17 That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are at Rome. I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, {Or is from faith to faith} just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

**7) Pray with faith in the Name of Jesus and make God's promises your own**

Exod 14:14 The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still.

Jer 5:14 Therefore this is what the LORD God Almighty says: "Because the people have spoken these words, I will make my words in your mouth a fire and these people the wood it consumes.

**G. AS A TEAM TOGETHER, PRAISE AND THANK THE LORD BEFORE YOU DEPART**

Ps 113:1-6 Praise the LORD. Praise, O servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD. Let the name of the LORD be praised, both now and for evermore. From the rising of the sun to the place where it sets, the name of the LORD is to be praised. The LORD is exalted over all the nations, his glory above the heavens. Who is like the LORD our God, the One who sits enthroned on high, who stoops down to look on the heavens and the earth?

Ps 103:8-14 For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust.

Ps 145:1-9 Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever. Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; his greatness no-one can fathom. One generation will commend your works to another; they will tell of your mighty acts. They will speak of the glorious splendour of your majesty, and I will meditate on your wonderful works. They will tell of the power of your awesome works, and I will proclaim your great deeds. They will celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness. The LORD is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The LORD is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made. (Also: Ps 119:130)
