

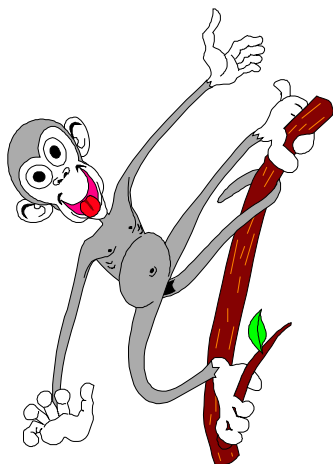
## **SECTION 7 JESUS FILM TRAINING MANUAL**

### **Topic 2: How to Start a JESUS-Film Ministry**

#### **A. STRATEGY**

##### **1. Take a step in faith and trust God for:**

- A Vision of how to get involved to win souls by using the JESUS-film Strategy.
- Faithful, available and teachable manpower. (FAT People)
- Available funds.



##### **2. Challenge Christians to become part of a JESUS-film team.**

- Spend time with them.
- Give them vision.
- Organize training for them.
- Divide available manpower into four teams with four to six members in each:
  - 4-6 Team members make a team. [Team Leader]
  - 4-6 Teams work in one JESUS-film area. [Area Leader]
  - 2-6 JESUS-film areas make one MPTA. [CCC Director]
  - Every team member must get his own job-description in the team.

##### **3. Decide which area you want to reach.**

- Divide the area into four target-areas, so that each team has its own responsible target-area to penetrate and do the follow-up.
- Every team has to make a study of its own target-area to find possible venues (show-areas) for the film shows.
- Identify church leaders in the show-areas, who desire to co-operate.
- Divide the show-areas in the target-area between team members, let two or more team-members be responsible for the church in the show-area.
- Team members are to visit the Spiritual Leaders of the church frequently to:
  - Build a relationship of trust.
  - Identify prayer requests.
  - Decide on a programme which will enable Church-members to be trained as counsellors, using: The "4SL" booklet and Follow-up series nr. 1-6.
- Pick a date for the film show.

##### **4. Sign a Partnering Contract with the Jesus Project office to:**

- Be provided with equipment.
- Help you set your goals.
- Make sure your statistics are reported back once a month.

##### **5. Mark all the available weeks of the year in order that:**

- Teams can take turns to use the equipment.
- Eg: 32 weekends divided by 4 teams = 8 outreaches per team.

- Decide beforehand on a yearly mass-outreach outside the country, to involve the whole group, using two or more sets of equipment. (Eg: After a LSA conference.)

## **6. Regular meetings must be scheduled:**

- Weekly meetings for team members should be arranged to:
  - Discuss the strategy.
  - Pray together.
- Monthly meetings of the four teams (JESUS-film Area) are important for:
  - Report back on the progress of teams in their respective areas.
  - Completing monthly statistics.
  - Receiving training and vision.
  - Discussing effectiveness and strategy.
  - Praying together.
- Schedule witnessing sessions during Sunday evening services at churches with the purpose of finding new team members and funds:
  - Witnessing should consist of :
    - How God changed lives of people who watched the film.
    - How God changes the lives of team members during outreaches.
    - Miracles out in the field.
  - Challenge churches to become involved in three areas:
    - Becoming part of a team.
    - Supporting the teams by debit-order.
    - Prayer support .

## **7. About the Outreaches:**

- Outreaches can only take place when people from the local church were trained and also equipped to do thorough follow-up.
- Show the film in the language of the viewers.
- Show the film over three or four consecutive nights.
- Use best available interpreters.
- New converts are invited to services of co-working churches.
- New converts are also invited to the follow-up and discipleship series that will take place in their church for the ten or more following weeks.



## **8. About the Follow-up:**

- The spiritual leader in the church in co-operation with the Team Leader who “fathers” the church, presents the training.
- Students are always encouraged to share their faith and personal testimonies with others until it becomes part of their lifestyle.
- At the completion of the course:
  - Every student receives a laminated certificate with his name on it.
  - He is also invited to become part of a JESUS-film team .








## **9. Second Jesus Film show.**

- The church and target area will be ready after about ten weeks, after completing the follow-up series nr. 1-6, for the second JESUS-film show.







