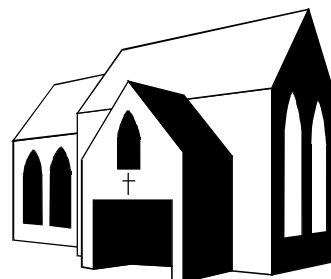


SECTION 4 JESUS FILM TRAINING MANUAL

Topic 4: Follow-Up and Discipleship

(During the next Six to Ten Weeks)



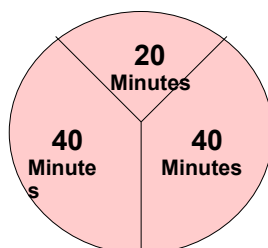
A. WEEKLY FOLLOW-UP

One and a half hours' follow-up on a weekly basis for a period of six to ten weeks.

(It is always wise to train the spiritual leader beforehand, so that he will not only be able to give some personal input during the follow-up, but that he himself will be the one to give the follow-up.)

Schedule for the weekly lessons.

Each lesson is divided into three different parts:



- Introduction
- Practical follow-up lessons 1-6
- Discipleship.

a. **Introduction.** (20 Minutes)

It can consist of:

- Group prayer;
- Sharing a Bible verse;
- Witnessing about personal witness;
- Revision of the previous week's work; etc.

b. **Practical follow-up lesson 1-6.** (40 Minutes)

Accompanying six follow-up studies "*Beginning Your New Life Series*", were developed by Campus Crusade For Christ and cover the basic spectrum of Christianity. Follow-up 1-6. (S8, AC, Page 173)

Some golden rules to remember:

- i) Encourage the students to bring their own Bible, pen and paper with them.
- ii) Students without Bibles must be helped to purchase their own Bibles at low cost.
- iii) It is important that, before you start with the lesson, they are taught how to look up a verse in their Bible.
- iv) Let the students prepare the next week's lesson as homework.
- v) Read each Bible verse at least 5 times, (in more than one understandable language) before the students come to a conclusion and the correct answers are checked.

(The students are usually not from a Christian background and they have

to be taught how to understand the Bible. If you are in a hurry to proceed, you might lose some of the students and not produce disciples.)

- vi) Complete a lesson in total before you start the next one.
- vii) It is more important that the students understand the content of the material, than that you only cover the material.

c. Discipleship. (40 Minutes)

- Motivate and train them to memorise and use the “4SL” booklet.

- A weekly check-out guide are very crucial: (Page 109)
 - To monitor your students' progress
 - To motivate the students to proceed to the end.
 - Motivate and help them to prepare and use their three minutes testimony in sharing their faith with others. (S1, T1, Page 7-11)



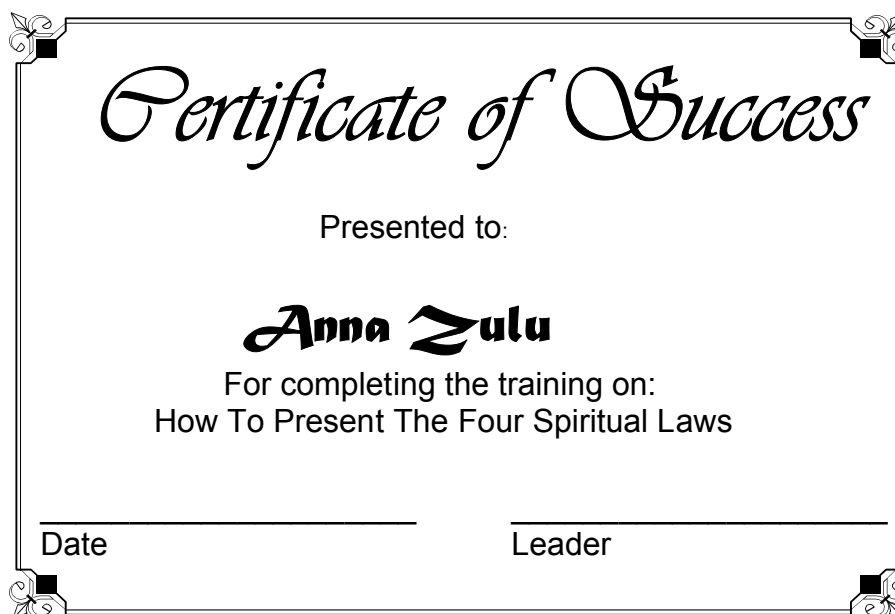
B. CERTIFICATE
